What is Karinya Young Mums (KYM)

KYM is a program provides accommodation and support for young parents in the Launceston area. The program aims to establish a safe, stable environment for parents and children while providing practical support.

You are eligible for KYM if you are

15-19 years of age* pregnant (over 20 weeks)

- and/or your youngest child is under two years of age

Are homeless or at risk of homelessness

- Able to live independently & motivated to work towards goals
- Willing to connect with Support Workers

*Entry age is negotiable on a case by case basis

What does KYM support looks like?

KYM Workers will support participants to reach their goals.

- Parenting health & information
- Improving independent living skills
- Maintaining tenancy responsibilities
- Connecting with community services
- Regular visit from Case Managers
- Participation in weekly group sessions
- Emotional & practical parenting support
